Conservation License Plate Advisory Committee

Attached are the components of the required annual report to the Conservation License Plate Committee from the Department of Cultural Resources. The report covers all grants made from the 2010 budget allocation. The Department of Cultural Resources received \$459,414 in grant applications for this grant cycle and was able to fund \$180,129 of those requests.

One third of all the funds allocated to the Department are used in the support of state assets that the Department oversees. The remaining two thirds of funds are divided equally between the Division of the Arts, the Division of Historical Resources, and the State Library, and administered through their existing grant programs.
